WHEREAS, this matter came on for consideration by the Court to amend Rule 5-103.2 NMRA of the Rules of Criminal Procedure for the District Courts, Rule LR2-203 NMRA of the Local Rules of the Second Judicial District Court, and LR12-201 NMRA of the Local Rules of the Twelfth Judicial District Court, and to adopt new Rule LR2-309 NMRA of the Local Rules of the Second Judicial District Court and LR12-301 NMRA of the Local Rules of the Twelfth Judicial District Court, and the Court having considered the foregoing and being sufficiently advised, Chief Justice Judith K. Nakamura, Justice Petra Jimenez Maes, Justice Charles W. Daniels, Justice Barbara J. Vigil, and Justice Gary L. Clingman concurring;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the amendment of Rules 5-103.2, LR2-203, and LR12-201 NMRA is APPROVED;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that new Rules LR2-309 and LR12-301 NMRA are ADOPTED;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above-referenced amendments shall be **effective for all cases pending or filed on or after January 14, 2019**; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court is authorized and directed to give notice of the above-referenced amendments by posting them on the New Mexico Compilation Commission web site and publishing them in the *Bar Bulletin* and *New Mexico Rules Annotated*.
